- Bible, pen, notepad
- Casual Clothes (one change for each day)
- Modest shorts and swimsuit (one-piece only)
- A reusable water bottle (or this may be purchased at camp)
- Light jacket, hat or cap, and a rain jacket or poncho
- Two pair of shoes one for everyday (flip-flops are not recommended) and one pair of old shoes (or water shoes) for water activities
- Sleeping bag or blanket and sheets for a twin size bed and a Pillow
- Towels (1 for showering and 1 for swimming) and washcloth
- Toiletries – soap, shampoo, toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.
- Hairbrush, hair dryer, comb
- Laundry bag for dirty clothes
- Prescription medication
  - Prescription medications need to be in the original bottle, with only the amount needed for the camper's stay at Kids' Camp All prescription bottles should come in a Ziploc bag with the camper's name written on it.
  - Over-the-counter medications brought to camp will not be accepted at check-in. Designated medical professionals are available at the Nurses' Station to dispense over-the-counter medication as needed. If an exception needs to be made for a child taking Claritin, Zyrtec, Miralax, etc., call the Youth Action office for an OTC Authorization form.
- Sunscreen
- Insect Repellant
- Flashlight
- Camera
- Your name on everything
  - All luggage must be clearly labeled with the camper's name, address, and phone number.
  - The best way to prevent lost items is to have all of your camper's clothing and belongings marked.  
Any items found in the bunkhouses will be laundered and held at our office for one week. If you have lost items, call the Family Life Youth Action office at 607-776-4151 with a complete description of the missing items. We will do our best to locate and return them to you. Any items not called for within one week will be donated to the Salvation Army.
- Spending Money
  - We suggest bringing \$8 - \$15  
The Kids' Camp General Store is open for those who wish to purchase snacks. Counselors will collect campers' money upon arrival at camp and place it on account in the General Store. All transactions will be made on account and remaining money will be returned to campers at check-out time.

### Items NOT to Bring

No electronic games  
No radios, CD, or MP3 players  
No clothing with vulgar or suggestive slogans  
No water guns or water balloons  
No firearms or fireworks\*

No over-the-counter medication  
No prank or gag materials  
No comics or magazines  
No knives of any kind  
No tobacco, drugs, or alcohol\*

\*Campers bringing these items into camp will be immediately dismissed
